SELF-HELP AND RESOURCE EXCHANGE PROGRAM (SHARE)

SHARE is a food buying club that offers nutritious food at a reduced cost. Each month's food package consists of a variety of fruit, meat, poultry, vegetables and staples. In addition, you may purchase additional food items not included in the monthly package. There are no eligibility requirements. Participants are asked to donate two volunteer hours every month.

FOOD RESOURCES

THE EMERGENCY FOOD ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (TEFAP)

The Emergency Food Assistance Program provides commodities to local food pantries. Recipients must be a Wisconsin resident and live within the pantry's service area. An application is required and the person's income must be below the Federal poverty guideline for the household size. Pantries subsidized by this program are located throughout the Green Bay area.

FOOD PANTRIES

Food pantries are located throughout Green Bay and are available to households who are in a food crisis. Many local churches will provide food on a monthly basis to households. Pantries are stocked with donations from businesses and people in the community.

MEAL SITES

Meal sites provide a hot, nutritious meal on a donation basis. Meals are normally served at 11:30 a.m.

FOODSHARE (Food Stamps)

This program helps people who have limited income purchase food they need for good nutrition. For further information, see the website:
