What are the park hours?

The Pet Exercise Area is open daily from 8:00 AM to Sunset. The park is open year-round.

Is there a fee to use the park?

Use of the Pet Exercise Area requires an Annual Permit or Daily Permit issued by the Brown County Facility & Park Department.

Daily Permits \$2

Daily passes are \$2 per dog and may be purchased right at the Dog Park. Please keep in mind that ALL dogs must be licensed to use the park!

Annual Passes \$15

You can purchase an annual permit at the kiosk. Fill out the envelope, insert your payment and we will mail it to you. It's as simple as that!

2010 GENERAL RULES for the Pet Exercise Area

Reminder ~ Dogs off-leash are only allowed in designated off-leash areas. Dogs must remain on leash in all other

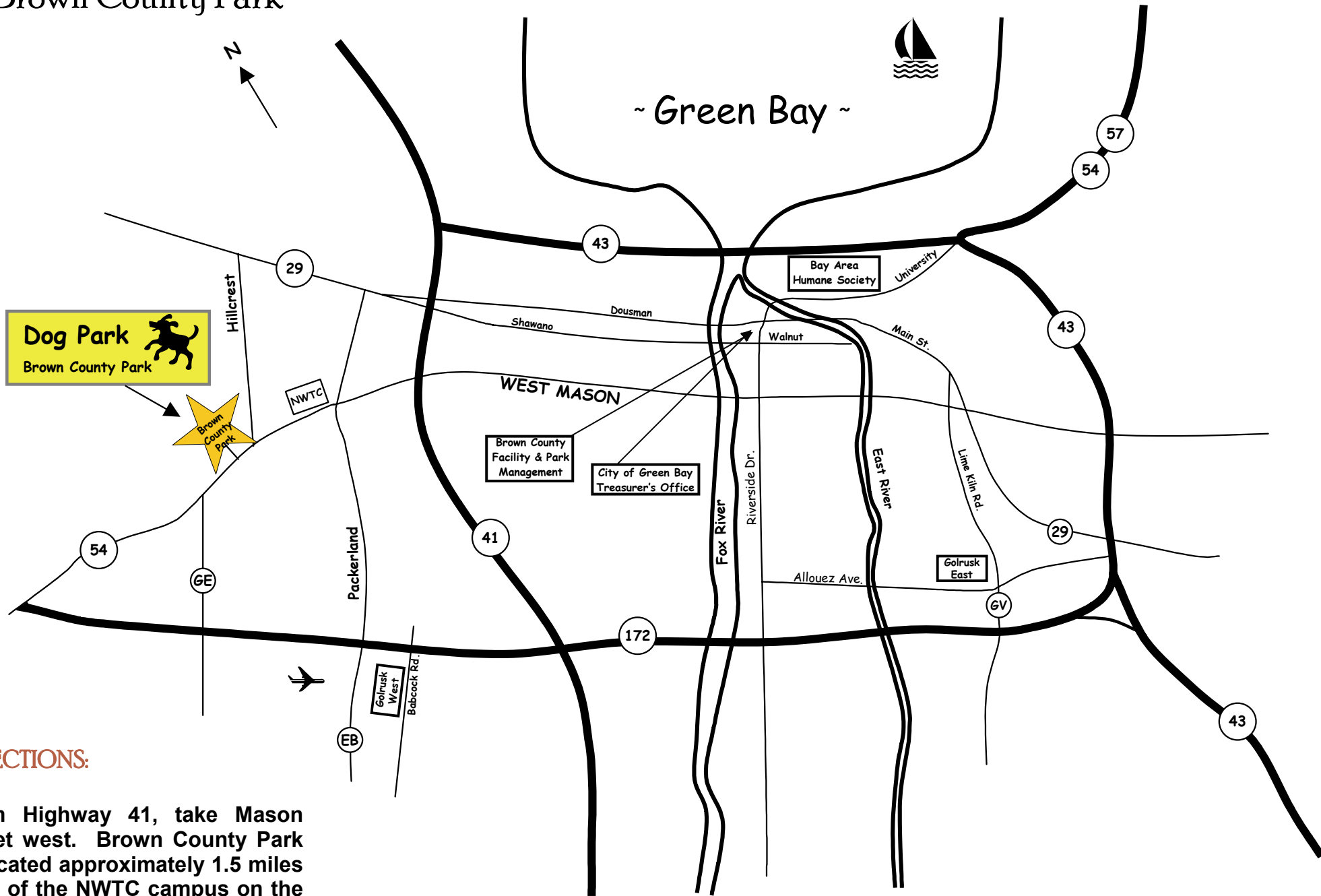
- ◆ Dogs must be licensed with current rabies vaccination per State law.
- ◆ Dogs must wear owner identification tags.
- ◆ Dog owners must carry a leash and clean-up bags.
- ◆ Dogs that are aggressive must be kept on a leash.
- ◆ Dogs in heat are prohibited.
- ◆ Dogs must be under supervision and voice control at all times—never leave your dog unattended!
- ◆ Dogs are not allowed on tables or benches.
- ◆ Owners must immediately clean up feces deposited by their dogs.
- ◆ Owners must stop dogs from digging holes, and must fill any holes created by their dogs.

DIRECTIONS:

From Highway 41, take Mason Street west. Brown County Park is located approximately 1.5 miles west of the NWTC campus on the right.
