The Friends of the FRT:

- Serves as a legislative liaison with WI State Government in Madison to stay abreast of trail expansions and trail enhancements. For example, the group worked to secure the 11-mile trail extension - six miles in Brown County from Greenleaf to Hilbert in Calumet County.
- Assists in trail safety with a Trail Patrol. Training is provided by Brown County. Patrol members are ambassadors who greet, help and inform trail users. They also report concerns to the Brown County Parks Department or police agencies.
- Sponsors work days to assist the Brown County Parks Department in trail maintenance and clean-up, including invasive weed species eradication and planting of wildflowers.
- Special fund raising activities for trail improvements. During 2007-2009 Friends of FRT raised private donations and participated in grant applications for paving an additional 3.8 miles of the trail south of De Pere.
