ANNUAL BOAT LAUNCH PASS REGISTRATION FORM

Additional Sticker \$5 *(one additional only)*

*A **second sticker** may be purchased if both boats are owned by the same individual. You must provide receipt for purchase of original sticker and boat registration for both boats to purchase a second sticker. Registrations must be current.

*A **replacement sticker** can only be issued if the old sticker is returned. Replacement stickers can only be purchased by showing proof of purchase of original sticker and signing a Verification Form that the original sticker is no longer in use. You must come to Brown County Facility & Park Office at 325 East Walnut Street, Room 220, during office hours of Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

*Second or replacement stickers must be purchased at one of our vendor locations or at the Brown County Facility & Park Management Office. For questions, call (920) 448-4057.

Thank you for requesting an annual pass boat launch pass. This pass will allow you to use boat launches operated by Brown County, the City of Green Bay and the City of De Pere. The pass is valid from January 1st to December 31st of the year the pass was purchased in.
