The 2011 Brown County 4-H program kicks-off October 1! Besides *National 4-H Week* activities, October 3-9, many 4-H clubs will be having their first meeting of the year this month. Youth interested in a

club office will be elected, club plans for the upcoming year will be developed, and enrollment or re-enrollment forms will be distributed to 4-H families. Parents are encouraged to review these forms, making the appropriate corrections or additions, advise their child on project selection, and talk about the expectations of all 4-H members. Here are some tips for completing the 2011 enrollment forms:

- **Verify Contact and Personal Information.** Review all of the contact and personal information on the first page of the enrollment form. Correct any items that are incorrect by putting a line through it and writing the correct information.
- **Name, Contact Information, Photo, and Accommodation Statements.** Check to make sure that all three of the statements located at the bottom of the first page of the enrollment form have been answered with a yes or no. Please be aware that we do not distribute or sell lists of 4-H members, families, or volunteers to anyone outside of our organization.
- **Communications Information.** Review the communications information found on page two of the enrollment form. Correct any items that are wrong and add any alternate cell phone or e-mail addresses that we can try to reach you at in case of an emergency.
- **Project Enrollment.** Help your child select the 4-H projects he/she is interested in taking this year. First year members are encouraged to take no more than 3 projects, with 20 being the maximum number of projects any 4-H member can enroll in. The average number of projects taken by Brown County 4-H member is less than 5. Here are some tips for helping your child select projects:
 - Review the Member Project Guide with your child. Check out the 4-H web site for more information about the projects.

- Talk with your child about their interests. Encourage him/her to take projects they want to do, not projects you think would be good.
- Encourage your child to try at least one new project this year. Youth who take a variety of projects tend to have a more satisfying 4-H experience than those who take the same project every year.
- Find out from your 4-H club leader who the project leader is for the projects your child wants to enroll in and contact them for more information about the project. If there isn't a leader for the project in your club or at the county level, consider being a leader yourself.

- **Signatures.** Be sure to sign and date the bottom of page 2 of the enrollment form and make sure your child has also signed the form. After you return the completed enrollment forms to your 4-H club leader, he/she will review it and sign the form before submitting it to the UW-Extension 4-H Office.
- **Brown County 4-H Youth Agreement.** Please review and discuss the items on the agreement form with your child. We want every child enrolled in 4-H to have a safe and enjoyable experience. Also be sure to review the revised Brown County 4-H Policies which you can find on the Brown County 4-H web site under *Forms and Documents*.

If you have any questions about 4-H enrollment, please contact your 4-H club leader. He/she should be able to answer your questions or will contact the 4-H Office if they don't know how to respond to your inquiry. Be sure to return the completed enrollment forms to your 4-H club leader as soon as you can, but no later than the deadline for your club. Your leader will review the forms for all of the members and leaders in the club and contact any 4-H families that have not fully completed the forms or if obvious errors are found. The leader will also sign all documents and return them to the UW-Extension Office with other required enrollment documents no later than December 1.

We look forward to working with you and your family this year and wish you the best for a wonderful 4-H year in 2011!

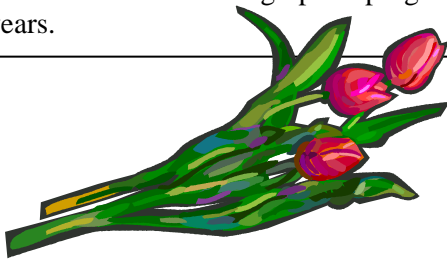
