

BROWN COUNTY DAIRY AND LIVESTOCK AUCTION SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Attached is an application form for the Brown County Dairy and Livestock Auction Scholarship. This scholarship was established by the Brown County Dairy and Livestock Auction Board to encourage our youth to continue their education. The scholarships are available through the funds generated through the Brown County Junior Fair's Dairy and Livestock Auction. Up to two \$500 scholarships will be awarded to applicants who are chosen. The scholarship will be awarded to the student after the first semester grades are turned into the Brown County UW Extension Office.

The following guidelines will govern the administration of the scholarship:

1. The scholarship will be presented to a graduating high school senior who has been auction *eligible* for at least three years.
2. The applicant must meet all criteria that is required for the current auction year.
3. The scholarship must be used within one year from the date of high school graduation.
4. The applicant must provide a copy of the college acceptance letter(s).
5. Provide one reference letter from either a 4-H Leader or teacher. Your reference person should discuss the following areas in the letter:
 - A. How the reference person knows the applicant.
 - B. Discuss the applicant's accomplishments.
 - C. Provide a summary including why the applicant deserves the scholarship.

(The reference letter must be attached to your completed application when submitted.)
