



## **4-H SET Team – Youth Leader**

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**Position Title:** 4-H SET Team Youth Leader

**Term of Responsibility:** August 1, 2009 – May 1, 2010

**Time Commitment:**

- Approximately 1 hour per month, August - March, working with 4-H SET Team to plan 4-H SET activities
- Average of 3 hours per month, September through April, attending and assisting with educational activities at 4-H SET Club meetings or camps
- Average of 2 hours per month, September through April, communicating with 4-H SET Team members and new 4-H SET Club volunteers
- Approximately 1 hours in April to complete final evaluations and reports

**Responsibilities:**

- Serve as the youth leader for the Brown County 4-H SET Team
- Attend team meetings and communicate with 4-H SET Team members on a regular basis
- Assist 4-H SET Team Coordinator in developing and implementing strategies to recruit youth members
- Serve as a positive role model and mentor for new 4-H SET Club youth members
- Help lead educational activities at 4-H SET Club meetings or camps
- Perform related functions as assigned

**Qualifications:**

- High school student
- Current 4-H member preferred
- Experience working with younger youth
- Ability to communicate with youth and adults
- Ability to organize, plan and carry out assignments
- Time to carry out the 4-H SET Team Junior Leader role
- Willingness to recruit new 4-H youth members
- Willingness to work with limited income, culturally diverse families

**Compensation:**

This is a volunteer position with a stipend of \$200.00 at the successful conclusion of the program. There is limited funding available for project supplies. All 4-H SET purchases must be authorized by the 4-H Youth Development Educator prior to purchase.

**Administrative Responsibility:**

The 4-H SET Team Youth Leader will be accountable to the Brown County UW-Extension 4-H Youth Development Educator for programmatic leadership and will be accountable to the Brown County UW-Extension Department Head for administrative issues.
