TASK LIST FOR GROUP REGARDING JAIL USAGE
(Prepared – Spring/Summer 2014)

1. **Judges Zuidmulder and Walsh and Clerk of Court:** Reduction of time between revocation order and sentencing on Misdemeanor and Felony charges.
2. **Judges Zuidmulder and Walsh and Clerk of Court:** Reduction in incarceration of people for fines. To include a break down as to what these offenses are such as payment hearings etc. Exploring option of using a collection agency instead.
3. **Chief Molitor:** Investigate proxy questions such as those used by Eau Claire.
4. **Jed Neuman and Jeremy Kral:** Investigate the feasibility of using COMPAS evaluations in pre-trial circumstances.
