Know that you are not alone! Many have struggled to stop using alcohol and/or drugs. Brown County has Alcohol and Other Drug Addiction (AODA) services you need to get help for yourself or a loved one\*. ### AODA Services & Treatment

Listed below are the different types of AODA services & treatments. Look for these terms on the following pages (pages 2-5) and the agencies that provide them in Brown County.

**Aftercare:** One-time weekly group therapy (16-32 weeks) facilitated by a therapist, typically following an intensive outpatient or residential treatment.

**Assessment:** Meet with an AODA counselor, who will ask & answer questions about your alcohol/other drug use, plus give recommendations about the appropriate level of services

**Co-Occurring Disorders Treatment Services:** Services that address both AODA & mental health issues.

**Day Treatment:** Meets during the day more than 12 hours per week, allowing you to return home in the evening.

**Group Therapy:** You meet with others who share similar issues in a group context 1-3 times per week. Groups are facilitated by a therapist.

**Individual Therapy:** Meet one-on-one with a therapist.

**Intensive Outpatient Therapy (IOP):** Meets up to 12 hours per week for groups therapy (average is 9 hours, 3 hours/3 times per week).

**Medically Monitored/Managed Inpatient Treatment:** 24/7 treatment in a hospital-like setting. Medical staff can administer medications and provide medical evaluations/care.

**Relapse Prevention:** If you attended treatment in the past & have relapse history, this group therapy focuses on relapse triggers, warning signs, & making a relapse prevention plan

**Residential Treatment:** 24/7 treatment in a non-medical, home-liked, unlocked environment.

**Other AODA Services & Treatment**

**Detoxification Hospitalization (Withdrawal):** 24/7 medical care to medically stabilize and assist you through severe and/or life-threatening withdrawal symptoms. If you have concerns about withdrawal symptoms, go to any area hospital's emergency room to have a doctor assess the need for inpatient detoxification. Based on the assessment, the doctor will recommend appropriate services.

**Detoxification (Methadone Treatment):** Accepted medical treatment for opiate dependence using methadone (a synthetic opiate).
