Effective June 1, 2009 - Passports are required for all land and sea crossings to and from Mexico and Canada.

As of January 23, 2007 - Passports are required for all air and sea travel to or from Canada, Mexico, Central and South America, the Caribbean, and Bermuda!

The Brown County Clerk's Office is open weekdays from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. to assist you with passport services. Passport applications, photo services, and Brown County Birth Certificates are all available in one convenient location.

Walk in service is always available; however, groups and families may choose to set up appointments to accommodate their busy schedules.

Don't wait too long to apply - normal processing time is approximately six weeks (depending on the amount of applications received at the Passport Agency). Expedited service, 2-4 weeks processing turn-around time, is also available.
