Rates for 25 - 39 sites will be regular nightly rates. Rates for 40 - 150 sites will be \$15.00 each per night. To reserve

Directions

From the City of Green Bay:

Take South Broadway toward De Pere, the street name changes to Fort Howard Avenue. The Fairgrounds is approximately five miles from downtown Green Bay.

Coming from Highway 41 from the North:

From Highway 41 take Highway 172 east to Ashland Avenue/Oneida Street exit. Follow the signs to Ashland Avenue and turn south onto Ashland. Take Ashland to Parkview Road and turn east. Turn right onto Fort Howard Avenue to enter the Park. The entrance will be on your left.

Coming from Highway 41 from the South:

Take Business 41/Ashland Avenue exit. Go through the roundabout onto Ashland Avenue. Turn right onto Parkview Road, then right onto Fort Howard Avenue. The Fairgrounds is immediately on the left.

Coming from Highway 43:

Take Highway 43 to 172 West. Cross over the Fox River. Exit onto Ashland Avenue/Oneida Street. Follow the signs to Ashland Avenue turning right onto Ashland. Turn left on Parkview Road, right on Fort Howard Avenue and the park entrance will be on your left.

Amenities

- Boat launch providing access to the Fox River. Enjoy boating, water sports and fishing (the lower Fox River is a world-class walleye fishery).
- Electrical pedestals have 20, 30 or 50 amp service.
- Dump station on site, no cost to campers.
- Campsites overlooking the Fox River available, nothing like camping with a water view!



Rules

- Camping is handled strictly on a first come, first served basis with self registration at the time of arrival. Reservations are not accepted. Camping is prohibited except in designated areas.
- Set-up and take-down is prohibited between the hours of 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. Check out time is 3 p.m. Quiet hours are between 10 pm and 9 am.
- No person shall remain for a period of more than 21 days in any 4 week period.
- Pets are permitted in designated campground areas only and must be on a leash at all times. All animal waste shall be immediately collected and disposed of properly.
- Campers must be 18 years or older to rent a camp site.
