A motion was made and approved to accept the October minutes.

Old Business:

Drug Diversion Agent's Status

- Struggling to work with pharmacies who are suspicious about prescriptions, but fill them anyway.
- Looking into ways to change ordinances which would include producing a photo I.D. when picking up prescriptions.
- Attempting to press the issue of not filling questionable prescriptions and following up with doctors.

New Business:

Lt. Poteat requested the following for authorization:

- \$15,000.00 for Drug Task Force for furnishings and equipment of the new office. This move is tentatively planned to take place between May and July of 2011. This motion was accepted.
- \$5,000.00 to purchase a used Allouez squad to utilize in drug interdictions, surveillance, and traffic cases. This squad is fully equipped and has lower mileage. This motion was accepted.

- \$5,000.00 for payment of small liens and for school fund shares for state forfeited vehicles. This motion was accepted.

A motion was made by Sheriff Gossage to adjourn the meeting at 10:22 a.m.
