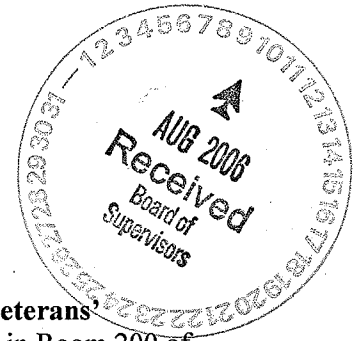


**PROCEEDINGS OF THE BROWN COUNTY  
VETERANS' RECOGNITION SUBCOMMITTEE**

1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER:

The meeting was called to order by Vice Chair Sherry Steenbock at 5:15 p.m.

2. APPROVE/MODIFY AGENDA:

**A MOTION WAS MADE BY MR. HASKINS AND SECONDED BY MR. BETTINE TO APPROVE THE AGENDA. Vote taken. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.**

3. APPROVE/MODIFY MINUTES OF April 11, 2006.

**A MOTION WAS MADE BY VICE CHAIR STEENBOCK AND SECONDED BY MR. BETTINE TO APPROVE THE MINUTES. Vote taken. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.**

4. ELECTION OF CHAIR

Vice Chair Steenbock asked for nominations for Chair.

**MOTION MADE BY JIM HASKINS TO NOMINATE JACK KRUEGER FOR CHAIR.**

**Chair Steenbock asked three times for any other nominations.**

**JACK KRUEGER WAS ELECTED CHAIR. UNANIMOUS VOTE.**

4. DISCUSSION RE: ESTABLISHING RECOGNITION OF BROWN COUNTY VETERANS.

Haskins reported that he would like to see more information signs put up at the VFW, American Legion, etc., letting vets know the certificates are available to them.

**MOTION TO Receive & place on file. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.**

6. DISCUSSION RE: FINALIZING DETAILS OF BROWN COUNTY FAIR.

Ms. Steenbock stated that she had spoken to Judy Knudsen (UW-Extension) regarding the Brown County Fair and the stage and signage had been taken care of. She also said the Howard-Suamico Band would be playing this year. Krispy Crème is supplying donuts again this year. (Krueger volunteered to pick them up and bring to fair grounds.) Haskins will be at the South Gate selling veteran family tickets again this year. Jerry Polus (Veterans Dept) stated they are also selling tickets in the Veterans' office, and he wanted to know if the committee thought a media press release would help inform vets that they are available. Krueger offered to write a media report and have it sent out with all the details.

Krueger wondered if we had a color guard for the event. The members told Krueger that no, but if they could get one, it would be real nice. Krueger stated that he would call the Oneida Color Guard since he knows some of the members.

The event will be held on Sunday, August 20, 2006 at 12:30 p.m. on the main stage. Krueger was asked to be the Master of Ceremonies and he agreed. Speakers are County Executive, Carol Kelso, and John Nusbaum, Vietnam Veteran. Ms. Steenbock asked Haskins to bring his bag of veteran buttons for the table.

7. SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS AUTHORIZED BY LAW:

Haskins read a reply he had received from Governor Jim Doyle and a number of other communications he had received and passed them around to the committee. It was suggested that matters be taken care of for the Veterans Day Event on Saturday, November 11, 2006, at the Brown County Veterans Memorial Complex. The committee will again work to have businesses offer discounts to Veterans on November 11<sup>th</sup> as well as, the many restaurants who offer to supply free meals to vets that day. Krueger wanted to have this item on next month's agenda.

The next scheduled meeting will be determined at a later date.
