The results were mostly favorable; some of the wording and the definition of a Veteran was changed, section 4501-12. Haskins stated that the wording on the bill will be changed as well for when Veteran's Day falls on a Saturday stating Veterans will have that day off with pay.

John Walschinski reported that he sent appreciation letters to Terry Kovarik from WFRV-TH / CH 5 and Amber Brown, Miss Wisconsin (attached) on behalf of Veterans of Brown County. Walschinski is looking into getting a digital frame donated and making up a disc of pictures to be placed on the counter in the Veteran's Department. Walschinski stated he is looking into getting the media involved to see if they can help remind Veterans to sign up for their certificates, Chair Krueger volunteered to contact radio personality John Maino.

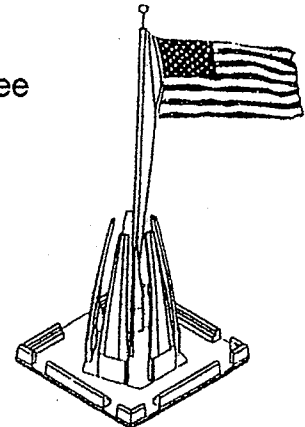

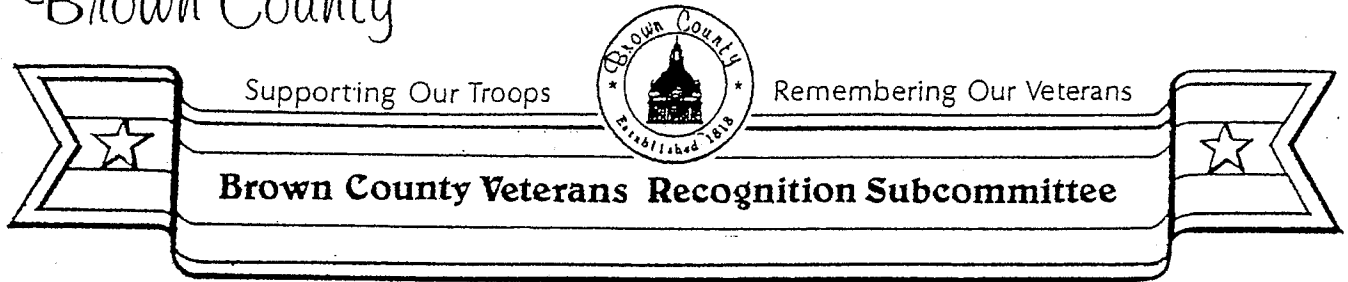

We all wish you continued success as Miss Wisconsin and beyond.

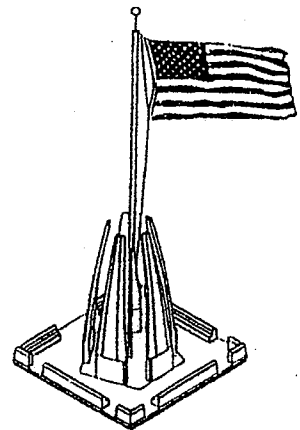
